

Esri Online Training

Students interested in taking Esri Online Training courses will need to email their professor to request access. Professors can submit individual students or their entire class rosters to Cise-IT@jmu.edu including student email addresses. Invitations will be sent to students requesting they register an existing Esri local account, or the student can create a new account for this purpose.

Once registered, students may go to <http://training.esri.com> and sign in. Any course available to our higher educational site license will then be available under the [training catalog](#):
